**[English, thawed, thawed out, dissolved, softened, liquefied, Opposite of, froze]**

- The manna that Yehowah gave to Israel in the wilderness **melted** in the daytime sun.
- And they would pick it up morning by morning, each one in proportion to his eating. When the sun got hot, it **melted**. (**Exodus 16:21**)
- When Yehowah's spirit became operative upon Sampson then the fetters with which he was bound simply **melted** from off his hands.
- He, for his part, came as far as Lehi, and the Philistines, for their part, shouted exultantly at meeting him. And Yehowah's spirit became operative upon him, and the ropes that were upon his arms came to be like linen threads that have been scorched with fire, so that his fetters **melted** off his hands.
