- The spies caused their brother's hearts to melt because they reported that the men in the land were greater and taller than they were.
- Where are we going up? Our brothers have caused our heart to melt, saying; A people greater and taller than we are, cities great and fortified to the heavens and also the sons of the Anakim we saw there. (Deuteronomy 1:28)
- Israelite men who did not want to fight in the army were exempted, so as to not make the hearts of others melt.
- And the officers must speak further to the people and say; Who is the man that is fearful and fainthearted? Let him go and return to his house, that he may not cause the hearts of his brothers to melt as his own heart. (Deuteronomy 20:8)
- Rahab showed, that the hearts of her people melted upon hearing of the exploits of Israel under Yehowah God's direction.
- When we got to hear it, then our hearts began to melt, and no spirit has arisen yet in anybody because of you, for Yehowah your God is God in the heavens above and on the earth beneath. (Joshua 2:11)
- When the kings of Canaan heard that Yehowah God had parted the Jordan River to allow them to enter the Promised Land their hearts melted.
- And it came about that as soon as all the kings of the Amorites, who were on the side of the Jordan to the west, and all the kings of the Canaanites, who were by the sea, heard that Yehowah had dried up the waters of the Jordan from before the sons of Israel until they had passed over, then their hearts began to melt, and there proved to be no spiritedness in them anymore because of the sons of Israel. (Joshua 5:1)
- When the men of Israel were defeated at Ai, then the heart of the people melted and became as water.

- And the men of Ai got to strike down about thirty-six men of them, and they went pursuing them from before the gate as far as Shebarim and continued striking them down on the descent. Consequently the heart of the people began to melt and became as water. (Joshua 7:5)
- Joshua showed that earlier when the heart of the people melted he stood firm in trusting in Yehowah God alone.
- And my brothers who went up with me caused the heart of the people to melt, but as for me, I followed Yehowah my God fully. (Joshua 14:8)
- Job likens the wicked man and his desires to sweet foods that seem tasteful, but produce bad results within a man the longer he stays with them, letting them melt up his tongue.
- If what is bad tastes sweet in his mouth, if he causes it to melt away under his tongue. (Job 20:12)
- The Psalmist shows, that when Yehowah God speaks powerfully toward the kingdoms of the earth to take up his rulership of the earth, then the nations, the mountains will melt away.
- The nations became boisterous, the kingdoms tottered, he sounded with his voice, the earth proceeded to melt. (Psalms 46:6)
- The mountains themselves proceeded to melt just like wax on account of Yehowah, on account of the Lord of the whole earth. (Psalms 97:5)
- The Psalmist shows that the very desires of the wicked one will melt away and the wicked ones will perish.
- The wicked one himself will see and certainly become vexed. He will grind his very teeth and actually melt away. The desire of the wicked ones will perish. (Psalms 112:10)
- They will get the import and suddenly realize, that Yehowah's Day is upon them, and they are not prepared for it. Their hands will drop down from their works, and their motivation, heart, will melt away, as they realize that all their works are nothing more than a

striving after wind, judgment. Yehowah disapproves of all their wicked works and judges them adversely.

- That is why all hands themselves will drop down, and the whole heart itself of mortal man will melt. (Isaiah 13:7)
- Egypt symbolically represents this entire system of things, and its Pharaoh represents Satan the Devil. Yehowah's great day is coming against all the land of Egypt, this wicked system, and like a cloud, which denotes Yehowah's presence, they will suddenly become aware of his presence among them for judgment. Then the valueless gods, in whom they have placed their trust, will quiver, and Egypt's heart will melt, when they feel the presence and power of the true God Yehowah.
- The pronouncement against Egypt! Look! Yehowah is riding on a swift cloud and coming into Egypt. And the valueless gods of Egypt will certainly quiver because of him, and the very heart of Egypt will melt in the midst of it. (Isaiah 19:1)
- What fellowship or communion with God, can there be with any people, when they have disfellowshipped his son, the Son of Man, God's High Priest? Clearly none! Yehowah has concealed his face from Jehovah's Witnesses, because they reject all true insight, divine light from him and from his true servants who present it to them. They will thus melt away, in their sins because of their error, which they refuse to see.
- And there is no one calling upon your name, no one rousing himself to lay hold on you, for you have concealed your face from us, and you cause us to melt by the power of our error. (Isaiah 64:7)
- Jehovah's Witnesses view themselves as the finest of all the many religions that are around the world, but it is they who have rejected the Messiah. When their world headquarters is destroyed it will cause all of the many hearts in support of her to melt. Also it will multiply those who are overthrown at her gates, for outside support of her by means of new ones, will be overthrown or turned back before they even reach the gates.
- In order for the heart to melt and in order to multiply those who are overthrown at all their gates, I will make a slaughter by the sword. Alas, it is made for a glittering, polished for a slaughter! (Ezekiel 21:15)

- Every day that an anointed Christian lives, should be lived with these things kept closely in mind. For when the time comes for that day to manifest itself, these symbolic heavens being on fire will be dissolved, and the elemental parts of Satan the Devil's system of things will melt down from the intense heat of Yehowah God's scrutiny upon them.
- Gone will be the governments of men dominated by Satan the Devil and his demons, also their corrupt commercial system, their false religion and their mighty military forces and police forces that keep mankind under oppression and in fear. Gone they will be forever!

- Awaiting and keeping close in mind the presence of the day of Yehowah, through which the heavens being on fire will be dissolved and the elements being intensely hot will melt! (2 Peter 3:12)
