- The 13th letter of the Hebrew alphabet. It is one of the five Hebrew letters that have a different form when used as the final letter of a word. In the Hebrew, it appears as the initial letter in each of the eight verses in;
- How I do love your Law! All day long it is my concern. (Psalms 119:97)
- Wiser than my enemies your commandment makes me, because to time indefinite it is mine. (Psalms 119:98)
- More insight than all my teachers I have come to have, because your reminders are a concern to me. (Psalms 119:99)
- With more understanding than older men I behave, because I have observed your own orders. (Psalms 119:100)
- From every bad path I have restrained my feet, for the purpose that I may keep your word. (Psalms 119:101)
- From your judicial decisions I have not turned aside, for you yourself have instructed me. (Psalms 119:102)
- How smooth to my palate your sayings have been, more so than honey to my mouth! (Psalms 119:103)
- Owing to your orders I behave with understanding. That is why I have hated every false path. (Psalms 119:104)
