[English, talked about, stated, cited, brought up, declared, pointed out, revealed, referred to, Opposite of, concealed]

- Israel went beyond the order of Yehowah God that he mentioned, by trying to go up to the mountain and prove successful there.
- Moreover, they got up early in the morning and tried to go up to the top of the mountain, saying; Here we are, and we have to go up to the place that Yehowah mentioned. For we have sinned. (Numbers 14:40)
- Yehowah God's angel told Manoah that everything he had mentioned to his wife she should do.
- So Yehowah's angel said to Manoah; From everything that I mentioned to the woman she should keep herself. (Judges 13:13)
- When the repurchaser Boaz mentioned to Ruth passed by he beckoned him.
- As for Boaz, he went up to the gate and began to sit there. And, look! The repurchaser was passing by, whom Boaz had mentioned. Then he said; Do turn aside, do sit down here, Soand-so. Hence he turned aside and sat down. (Ruth 4:1)
- Eli at the moment he mentioned the ark of the covenant fell over and died when his neck broke.
- And it came about that at the moment that he mentioned the ark of the true God, he began to fall from the seat backward beside the gate, and his neck got broken so that he died, because the man was old and heavy, and he himself had judged Israel forty years. (1 Samuel 4:18)
- David told Michal that with the slave girls she had mentioned when she criticized him, he would glorify himself, yet she remained childless to the day of her death.
- And I will make myself even more lightly esteemed than this, and

I will become low in my eyes, and with the slave girls whom you mentioned, with them I am determined to glorify myself. (2 Samuel 6:22)

- Job showed that among valuable things corals and rock crystals would not even be mentioned along with wisdom which is more valuable than pearls.
- Coral and rock crystal themselves will not be mentioned, but a bagful of wisdom is worth more than one full of pearls. (Job 28:18)
- Also, in a way that befits holy people, things such as fornication, uncleanness, and greediness, should not even be mentioned among them. Therefore gossiping about wicked things or mentioning the faults of others, backbiting and criticism, are inappropriate in the anointed congregation of God.
- Let fornication and uncleanness of every sort or greediness not even be mentioned among you, just as it befits holy people. (Ephesians 5:3)
