(Me-shul'lam) [from a root meaning, make peace, compensate, repay]

- A priest whose descendants, at least three generations after him, lived in Jerusalem after the exile in Babylon.
- And the first inhabitants that were in their possession in their cities were the Israelites, the priests, the Levites and the Nethinim. (1 Chronicles 9:2)
- And in Jerusalem there dwelt some of the sons of Judah and some of the sons of Benjamin and some of the sons of Ephraim and of Manasseh. (1 Chronicles 9:3)
- And of the priests there were Jedaiah and Jehoiarib and Jachin. (1 Chronicles 9:10)
- And Adaiah the son of Jeroham the son of Pashhur the son of Malchijah, and Maasai the son of Adiel the son of Jahzerah the son of Meshullam the son of Meshillemith the son of Immer. (1 Chronicles 9:12)
