

~MESHULLAM 6 (24)

(Me-shul'lam) [from a root meaning, make peace, compensate, repay]

- **A priest whose descendants, at least three generations after him, lived in Jerusalem after the exile in Babylon.**
- **And the first inhabitants that were in their possession in their cities were the Israelites, the priests, the Levites and the Nethinim. (1 Chronicles 9:2)**
- **And in Jerusalem there dwelt some of the sons of Judah and some of the sons of Benjamin and some of the sons of Ephraim and of Manasseh. (1 Chronicles 9:3)**
- **And of the priests there were Jedaiah and Jehoiarib and Jachin. (1 Chronicles 9:10)**
- **And Adaiah the son of Jeroham the son of Pashhur the son of Malchijah, and Maasai the son of Adiel the son of Jahzerah the son of **Meshullam** the son of Meshillemith the son of Immer. (1 Chronicles 9:12)**
