(Me-shul'lam) [from a root meaning, make peace, compensate, repay ]

- A Benjamite whose son Sallu was a family head in Jerusalem after the Babylonian exile.
- And in Jerusalem there dwelt some of the sons of Judah and some of the sons of Benjamin and some of the sons of Ephraim and of Manasseh. (1 Chronicles 9:3)
- And of the sons of Benjamin, Sallu the son of Meshullam the son of Hodaviah the son of Hassenuah. (1 Chronicles 9:7)
- And the brothers of theirs by their descendants were nine hundred and fifty-six. All these were men that were heads of the fathers by the house of their forefathers. (1 Chronicles 9:9)
- Presumably the same as the Meshullam listed in;
- And these were the sons of Benjamin. Sallu the son of Meshullam the son of Joed the son of Pedaiah the son of Kolaiah the son of Maaseiah the son of Ithiel the son of Jeshaiah. (Nehemiah 11:7)
