(Me-shul'lam) [from a root meaning, make peace, compensate, repay]

- A Benjamite family head who himself lived in Jerusalem after the exile.
- And in Jerusalem there dwelt some of the sons of Judah and some of the sons of Benjamin and some of the sons of Ephraim and of Manasseh. (1 Chronicles 9:3)
- And of the sons of Benjamin, Sallu the son of Meshullam the son of Hodaviah the son of Hassenuah. (1 Chronicles 9:7)
- And Ibneiah the son of Jeroham, and Elah the son of Uzzi the son of Michri, and Meshullam the son of Shephatiah the son of Reuel the son of Ibnijah. (1 Chronicles 9:8)
- And the brothers of theirs by their descendants were nine hundred and fifty-six. All these were men that were heads of the fathers by the house of their forefathers. (1 Chronicles 9:9)
