

~MIJAMIN 4 (29)

(Mij'a-min) [From the Right Hand]

- A priest, or possibly the ancestor of a priest, listed among those attesting by seal the **trustworthy arrangement** of Nehemiah's time.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (**Nehemiah 9:38**)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (**Nehemiah 10:1**)
- Meshullam, Abijah, **Mijamin**. (**Nehemiah 10:7**)
- Maaziah, Bilgai and Shemaiah, these being the priests. (**Nehemiah 10:8**)
- He seems to be identical with the **Miniamin** of;
- And the priests Eliakim, Maaseiah, **Miniamin**, Micaiah, Elioenai, Zechariah, Hananiah with the trumpets. (**Nehemiah 12:41**)
- In **Hebrew**, **Mijamin** seems to be a contraction of the name **Miniamin**.
