- A priest, or possibly the ancestor of a priest, listed among those attesting by seal the trustworthy arrangement of Nehemiah's time.
- So in view of all this we are contracting a trustworthy arrangement, both in writing and attested by the seal of our princes, our Levites and our priests. (Nehemiah 9:38)
- Now attesting it by seal there were, Nehemiah the Tirshatha, the son of Hacaliah, and Zedekiah. (Nehemiah 10:1)
- Meshullam, Abijah, Mijamin. (Nehemiah 10:7)
- Maaziah, Bilgai and Shemaiah, these being the priests.
 (Nehemiah 10:8)
- He seems to be identical with the Miniamin of;
- And the priests Eliakim, Maaseiah, Miniamin, Micaiah, Elioenai, Zechariah, Hananiah with the trumpets. (Nehemiah 12:41)
- In Hebrew, Mijamin seems to be a contraction of the name Miniamin.
