

~MINNITH (41)
(Min'nith)

- One of 20 Ammonite cities that Jephthah subdued after making his vow to Yehowah.
- Then Jephthah made a vow to Yehowah and said; If you without fail give the sons of Ammon into my hand. (**Judges 11:30**)
- It must also occur that the one coming out, who comes out of the doors of my house to meet me when I return in peace from the sons of Ammon, must also become Yehowah's, and I must offer that one up as a burnt offering. (**Judges 11:31**)
- So Jephthah passed along to the sons of Ammon to fight against them, and Yehowah proceeded to give them into his hand. (**Judges 11:32**)
- And he went striking them from Aroer all the way to **Minnith**, twenty cities, and as far as Abel-keramim with a very great slaughter. Thus the sons of Ammon were subdued before the sons of Israel. (**Judges 11:33**)
- Centuries later **wheat of Minnith** is mentioned as an item of Tyre's trade.
- And as for you, O son of man, raise up concerning Tyre a dirge. (**Ezekiel 27:2**)
- Judah and the land of Israel themselves were your traders. For the **wheat of Minnith** and special foodstuff and honey and oil and balsam, your articles of exchange were given. (**Ezekiel 27:17**)
- The exact location of **Minnith** is not known. One of a number of possible identifications is **Khirbet Hanizeh**, **Umm el Hanafish**, about 6 kilometers (3.5 miles) East-Northeast of Heshbon.
