## ~MISLEADING (83)

[English, deceptive, ambiguous, confusing, false, disingenuous, Opposite of, truthful]

- Jeremiah showed that within Jerusalem before her fall many false prophets came forth misleading her with worthless human pronouncements that were not according to the counsel of Yehowah God.
- Your own prophets have visioned for you worthless and unsatisfying things; And they have not uncovered your error in order to turn back your captivity; But they kept visioning for you worthless and misleading pronouncements. (Lamentations 2:14)
- Paul then reveals to Timothy, that the true inspired utterance definitely says, even then, that in later periods of time, some Christians will fall away from the faith, the same faith, that he and Timothy have been taught, through the Holy Spirit, and that those men will pay attention to misleading inspired utterances and the teachings of demons, and not to God.
- However, the inspired utterance says definitely that in later periods of time some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to misleading inspired utterances and teachings of demons. (1 Timothy 4:1)
- Paul then shows, that during the Last Days, wicked men will then advance from bad to worse, they will mislead others, and they themselves will be misled by others.
- But wicked men and impostors will advance from bad to worse,
  misleading and being misled. (2 Timothy 3:13)
- Were any anointed Christian to make the statement, that he did not have any sin, he would only be misleading his own mind, and the truth would not be in such a one, for all men are sinful, and there is not a single one that does not sin.
- Christianity is not about overly pompous men who think of themselves as holier than thou, but it is about humble knowledgeable men who see matters from Yehowah's standpoint, and fully realize

their fallen sinful condition before him, men who appreciate his undeserved kindness toward them through his Christ.

- If we make the statement; We have no sin, we are misleading ourselves and the truth is not in us. (1 John 1:8)
- Here the great dragon is clearly identified as the one who began this slander of God, becoming his resister and opposer. Throughout mankind's long history he has misled all of mankind by the means of false religion. Sometimes the falseness of a religion is more obvious as in Buddhism or Confusism, and sometimes it is much more subtle as with Christendom and especially Jehovah's Witnesses.
- So down the great dragon was hurled, the original serpent, the one called Devil and Satan, who is misleading the entire inhabited earth, he was hurled down to the earth, and his angels were hurled down with him. (Revelation 12:9)
- The Lake of Fire and Sulphur is the second death. Fire and sulphur denotes being completely burned so that nothing remains. Satan, Jehovah's Witnesses, their false prophet, wicked anointed rulers and many other things are thrown into the Lake of Fire and none of them ever come back again. The torment that never ends is that life for such individuals and organizations is gone forever. Satan already knows his judgment, and so he is in torment now until he is completely destroyed.
- And the Devil who was misleading them was hurled into the lake of fire and sulphur, where both the wild beast and the false prophet already were, and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever. (Revelation 20:10)
