[English, gives the wrong impression about, misinforms, deceives, lies to, hoodwinks, deludes, takes in]

- Jesus counseled his disciples to look out that nobody **misleads** them for many false Christ's would come. They were not to follow anyone seeking prominence from others because the true Christ would come as a thief.
- And in answer Jesus said to them; Look out that nobody **misleads** you! (**Matthew 24:4**)
- So Jesus started to say to them; Look out that nobody **misleads** you. (**Mark 13:5**)
- Some of Jesus opposers said that he **misleads** others.
- And there was a lot of subdued talk about him among the crowds. Some would say; He is a good man. Others would say; He is not, but he **misleads** the crowd. (**John 7:12**)
- Jesus warned that congregations about a Jezebel influence who would **mislead** the congregations.
- Nevertheless, I do hold this against you, that you tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and **misleads** my slaves to commit fornication and to eat things sacrificed to idols. (**Revelation 2:20**)
