## ~MIZPAH 5 (23)

(Miz'pah) [Mizpeh, Miz'peh, meaning, Watchtower ]

- A city of Moab where David, while outlawed by King Saul, settled his parents.
- Later David went from there to Mizpeh in Moab and said to the king of Moab; Let my father and my mother, please, dwell with you people until I know what God will do to me. (1 Samuel 22:3)
- Mizpeh's precise location cannot be established definitely. Some scholars believe it may be the same place as Kir of Moab.
- The pronouncement against Moab; Because in the night it has been despoiled, Ar of Moab itself has been silenced. Because in the night it has been despoiled, Kir of Moab itself has been silenced. (Isaiah 15:1)
- Others have suggested Ruzm el-Mesrife, situated West-southwest of Madaba, ancient Medeba, as an identification.
