- Older men and women should be likewise moderate in habits.
- Women should likewise be serious, not slanderous, moderate in habits, faithful in all things. (1 Timothy 3:11)
- Let the aged men be moderate in habits, serious, sound in mind, healthy in faith, in love, in endurance. (Titus 2:2)
