

~MOLEST (38)

[English, assault, interfere with, abuse, mistreat]

- The Israelites in the wilderness were told not to molest **Moab**.
- Yehowah then said to me; Do not **molest** Moab or engage in war with them, because I shall not give you any of his land as a holding, for to the sons of Lot I have given Ar as a holding. (**Deuteronomy 2:9**)
- And you must get close in front of the sons of Ammon. Do not **molest** them or engage in strife with them, because I shall not give you any of the land of the sons of Ammon as a holding, for it is to the sons of Lot that I have given it as a holding. (**Deuteronomy 2:19**)
- Ruth was allowed to glean among Boaz's workers without being **molested** by them.
- Then she got up to glean. Boaz now commanded his young men, saying; Let her glean also among the cut-off ears of grain, and you must not **molest** her. (**Ruth 2:15**)
- David and his men did not **molest** Nabal's workers or flocks providing them with protection instead.
- And now I have heard that you have shearers. Now the shepherds that belong to you happened themselves to be with us. We did not **molest** them, and nothing at all showed up missing of theirs all the days they happened to be in Carmel. (**1 Samuel 25:7**)
- And the men were very good to us, and they did not **molest** us, and we did not miss a single thing all the days of our walking about with them while we happened to be in the field. (**1 Samuel 25:15**)
