

**~MOREH 2 (16)**  
**(Mo'reh)**

- The name of a hill, in the vicinity of which the Midianites were defeated by Gideon.
- Then Jerubbaal, that is to say; Gideon, and all the people who were with him, rose early and took up camping at the well of Harod, and the camp of Midian happened to be on the north of him, at the hill of **Moreh**, in the low plain. (**Judges 7:1**)
- This hill is generally thought to be the bare gray ridge of **Jebel Dahi, Giv`at Ha-More**, about 8 kilometers (5 miles) North of the suggested site for the well of Harod.
