~MOSERAH (30) (Mo-se'rah) [Moseroth, Mo-se'roth]

- The place where the Israelites were encamped when Aaron died.
- And the sons of Israel pulled away from Beeroth Bene-jaakan for Moserah. There Aaron died, and he got to be buried there, and Eleazar his son began to act as priest instead of him.

 (Deuteronomy 10:6)
- It was evidently near Mount Hor, whereon Aaron died, but its exact location is unknown.
- And Aaron the priest proceeded to go up into Mount Hor at the order of Yehowah and to die there in the fortieth year of the going out of the sons of Israel from the land of Egypt, in the fifth month, on the first of the month. (Numbers 33:38)
- The plural form of Moserah, Moseroth, appears at;
- Next they pulled away from Hashmonah and went camping in Moseroth. (Numbers 33:30)
- Then they pulled away from Moseroth and went camping in Bene-jaakan. (Numbers 33:31)
- And apparently refers to an earlier Israelite encampment there.
