

## ~MURMURING (92)

[English, speaking softly, talking softly, muttering, whispering, mumbling]

- Moses warned Israel that Yehowah God had heard their **murmurings**, that they were **murmuring** against him.
- And Moses continued; It will be when Yehowah gives you in the evening meat to eat and in the morning bread to satisfaction, because Yehowah has heard your **murmurings** that you are murmuring against him. And what are we? your murmurings are not against us, but against Yehowah. (**Exodus 16:8**)
- How long will this evil assembly have this **murmuring** that they are carrying on against me? I have heard the **murmurings** of the sons of Israel that they are **murmuring** against me. (**Numbers 14:27**)
- The men of Israel went to **murmuring** against Moses and against Yehowah God for their lack of water.
- And the people went on thirsting there for water, and the people kept **murmuring** against Moses and saying; Why is it that you have brought us up out of Egypt to put us and our sons and our livestock to death by thirst? (**Exodus 17:3**)
- Yehowah God showed his choice from among the tribe leaders to represent him, by making the rod of Aaron bud with ripe almonds and flowers so as to quiet the **murmurings** of the Israelite nation.
- And what must occur is that the man whom I shall choose, his rod will bud, and I shall certainly make subside from against me the **murmurings** of the sons of Israel, which they are murmuring against you. (**Numbers 17:5**)
- Now on seeing that their teacher ate and drank with sinners and tax collectors, the scribes and Pharisees began to **murmur** against his disciples, saying to them; Why is it that you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners? They said this, because they themselves would never do so, for they considered themselves above such men.
- At this the Pharisees and their scribes began **murmuring** to his

disciples, saying; Why is it you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners? ([Luke 5:30](#))

- So in answer Jesus told them to stop **murmuring** among themselves.
- In answer Jesus said to them; Stop **murmuring** among yourselves. ([John 6:43](#))
- So Jesus replied, as he saw how many of his disciples were **murmuring** against him; Does this stumble you?
- But Jesus, knowing in himself that his disciples were **murmuring** about this, said to them; Does this stumble you? ([John 6:61](#))
- Now the Pharisees were also listening to the talk among the people, as they were **murmuring** these things about Jesus, and so they dispatched officers of the temple, to take hold of him.
- The Pharisees heard the crowd **murmuring** these things about him, and the chief priests and the Pharisees dispatched officers to get hold of him. ([John 7:32](#))
- So then, because of their bold witnessing work, their numbers kept expanding. Later though, a **murmuring** came about on the part of the Greek speaking Jews, against the Hebrew speaking Jews, because they felt, that their widows were being overlooked, in the daily food distribution.
- Now in these days, when the disciples were increasing, a **murmuring** arose on the part of the Greek-speaking Jews against the Hebrew-speaking Jews, because their widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution. ([Acts of Apostles 6:1](#))
