

~NAAMAN 1 (33)

(Na'a-man) [from a root meaning, be pleasant]

- A grandson of Benjamin through his firstborn Bela.
- As for Benjamin, he became father to Bela his firstborn, Ashbel the second and Aharah the third. (1 Chronicles 8:1).
- Nohah the fourth and Rapha the fifth. (1 Chronicles 8:2)
- And Bela came to have sons, Addar and Gera and Abihud. (1 Chronicles 8:3)
- And Abishua and Naaman and Ahoah. (1 Chronicles 8:4)
- And Naaman and Ahijah, and Gera, he was the one that took them into exile, and he became father to Uzza and Ahihud. (1 Chronicles 8:7)
- Having founded a family, the Naamites in the tribe of Benjamin.
- The sons of Bela came to be Ard and Naaman. Of Ard the family of the Ardites. Of Naaman the family of the Naamites. (Numbers 26:40)
- Naaman himself is elsewhere listed as one of the sons of Benjamin.
- And the sons of Benjamin were Bela and Becher and Ashbel, Gera and Naaman, Ehi and Rosh, Muppim and Huppim and Ard. (Genesis 46:21)
