(Na'a-ran) [from a root meaning, shake off]

- An Ephraimite border city,
- And the sons of Ephraim were Shuthelah and Bered his son and Tahath his son and Eleadah his son and Tahath his son. (1 Chronicles 7:20)
- And their possession and their dwelling places were Bethel and its dependent towns and, to the east, Naaran and, to the west, Gezer and its dependent towns, and Shechem and its dependent towns clear to Gaza and its dependent towns. (1 Chronicles 7:28)
- Apparently the same as Naarah.
- And the boundary of the sons of Ephraim by their families came to be, yes, the boundary of their inheritance toward the east came to be Ataroth-addar, as far as Upper Beth-horon. (Joshua 16:5)
- And it went down from Janoah to Ataroth and Naarah and reached to Jericho and went out to the Jordan. (Joshua 16:7)
