- The name of the threshing floor where Uzzah died for grabbing hold of the ark of the covenant. The parallel account at;
- And they came gradually as far as the threshing floor of Chidon, and Uzzah now thrust his hand out to grab hold of the Ark, for the bulls nearly caused an upset. (1 Chronicles 13:9)
- Says Chidon, probably indicating that one writer mentioned the name of the place, the other that of its owner, or that one name is an altered form of the other.
