## ~NAPHTALI 1 (106) (Naph'ta-li) [My Wrestlings]

- The second son born to Jacob by Rachel's maidservant Bilhah in Paddan-aram.
- And the sons by Bilhah, Rachel's maidservant, were Dan and Naphtali. (Genesis 35:25)
- And the sons by Zilpah, Leah's maidservant, were Gad and Asher. These are Jacob's sons who were born to him in Paddanaram. (Genesis 35:26)
- Now these are the names of Israel's sons who came into Egypt with Jacob, each man and his household came. (Exodus 1:1)
- Dan and Naphtali, Gad and Asher. (Exodus 1:4)
- These were the sons of Israel, Reuben, Simeon, Levi and Judah, Issachar and Zebulun. (1 Chronicles 2:1)
- Dan, Joseph and Benjamin, Naphtali, Gad and Asher. (1
   Chronicles 2:2)
- Since Bilhah had substituted for her mistress Rachel, Naphtali, like his older full brother Dan, was considered by barren Rachel as her own son. Although her sister Leah by then already had four sons
- And Leah became pregnant and brought a son to birth and then called his name Reuben, for she said; It is because Yehowah has looked upon my wretchedness, in that now my husband will begin to love me. (Genesis 29:32)
- And she became pregnant again and brought a son to birth and then said; It is because Yehowah has listened, in that I was hated and so he gave me also this one. Hence she called his name Simeon. (Genesis 29:33)
- And she became pregnant yet again and brought a son to birth and then said; Now this time my husband will join himself to me, because I have borne him three sons. His name was therefore called Levi. (Genesis 29:34)

- And she became pregnant once more and brought a son to birth and then said; This time I shall laud Yehowah. She therefore called his name Judah. After that she left off giving birth. (Genesis 29:35)
- Rachel was elated over her success in getting a second son through her maidservant and exclaimed; With strenuous wrestlings I have wrestled with my sister.
- I have also come off winner! The name given to this son, Naphtali, meaning, My Wrestlings, appropriately expressed Rachel's feelings at the time of his birth.
- At this Jacob's anger burned against Rachel and he said; Am I in the place of God, who has held back the fruit of the belly from you? (Genesis 30:2)
- So she said; Here is my slave girl Bilhah. Have relations with her, that she may give birth upon my knees and that I, even I, may get children from her. (Genesis 30:3)
- With that she gave him Bilhah her maidservant as wife, and Jacob had relations with her. (Genesis 30:4)
- And Bilhah became pregnant and in time bore Jacob a son. (Genesis 30:5)
- Then Rachel said; God has acted as my judge and has also listened to my voice, so that he gave me a son. That is why she called his name Dan. (Genesis 30:6)
- And Bilhah, Rachel's maidservant, became pregnant once more and in time bore a second son to Jacob. (Genesis 30:7)
- Then Rachel said; With strenuous wrestlings I have wrestled with my sister. I have also come off winner! So she called his name Naphtali. (Genesis 30:8)
- Later, Naphtali himself became the father of four sons, Jahzeel or Jahziel, Guni, Jezer, and Shillem, or Shallum.
- And the sons of Naphtali were Jahzeel and Guni and Jezer and Shillem. (Genesis 46:24)

- The sons of Naphtali were Jahziel and Guni and Jezer and Shallum, the sons of Bilhah. (1 Chronicles 7:13)
- When the dying patriarch Jacob related to his sons what would happen to them in the final part of the days, his statement about Naphtali, though one of the briefest, was favorable.
- Later on Jacob called his sons and said; Gather yourselves together that I may tell you what will happen to you in the final part of the days. (Genesis 49:1)
- Assemble yourselves and listen, you sons of Jacob, yes, listen to Israel your father. (Genesis 49:2)
- Naphtali is a slender hind. He is giving words of elegance.
   (Genesis 49:21)
