

**~NAPHTUHIM (29)**  
**(Naph-tu'him)**

- Listed as among the descendants of Mizraim, the son of Ham.
- And the sons of Ham were Cush and Mizraim and Put and Canaan. (**Genesis 10:6**)
- And Mizraim became father to Ludim and Anamim and Lehabim and **Naphtuhim**. (**Genesis 10:13**)
- And Pathrusim and Casluhim, from among whom the Philistines went forth and Caphtorim. (**Genesis 10:14**)
- As for Mizraim, he became father to Ludim and Anamim and Lehabim and **Naphtuhim**. (**1 Chronicles 1:11**)
- And Pathrusim and Casluhim, from among whom the Philistines went forth, and Caphtorim. (**1 Chronicles 1:12**)
- As with the other names in this list, scholars usually take the apparent plural form to indicate a tribe or people. Assuming the name to derive from some geographic relationship, scholars often associate **Naphtuhim** with an Egyptian phrase meaning, **those of the Delta**, and on this basis the **Naphtuhim** are included among the inhabitants of Lower, northern Egypt. The correctness of these views is not as yet conclusive.
