~NEARIAH 1 (17) (Ne-a-ri'ah) [Boy, or Young Man of Yah]

- A Simeonite, son of Ishi. Neariah and his three brothers headed a force of 500 men that defeated the Amalekites at Mount Seir and thereafter continued to dwell there.
- And from them there were some of the sons of Simeon that went to Mount Seir, five hundred men, with Pelatiah and Neariah and Rephaiah and Uzziel the sons of Ishi at their head. (1 Chronicles 4:42)
- And they proceeded to strike down the remnant that had escaped of Amalek, and they continued to dwell there down to this day. (1 Chronicles 4:43)
