## ~NEBALLAT (16) (Ne-bal'lat)

- A place settled by Benjamites after the Babylonian exile.
- And the sons of Benjamin were from Geba, Michmash and Aija and Bethel and its dependent towns. (Nehemiah 11:31)
- Hadid, Zeboim, Neballat. (Nehemiah 11:34)
- Neballat is generally identified with Beit Nebala, Horvat Nevallat. Situated on a low hill about 6 kilometers (3.5 miles) East-Northeast of modern Lydda, or Lod, Beit Nebala overlooks the Southeast end of the Plain of Sharon.
