## ~**NECKLACE** (104)

- An ornamental chain or string of beads, gold, silver, coral, jewels, and the like, worn around the neck. Necklaces were anciently worn by women.
- Your cheeks are comely among the hair braids, your neck in a string of beads. (Song of Solomon 1:10)
- You have made my heart beat, O my sister, my bride, you have made my heart beat by one of your eyes, by one pendant of your necklace. (Song of Solomon 4:9)
- And I went on to deck you with ornaments and to put bracelets upon your hands and a necklace about your throat. (Ezekiel 16:11)
- And even by men, especially those of high station.
- And Pharaoh added to Joseph; See, I do place you over all the land of Egypt. (Genesis 41:41)
- With that Pharaoh removed his signet ring from his own hand and put it upon Joseph's hand and clothed him with garments of fine linen and placed a necklace of gold about his neck. (Genesis 41:42)
- The king was calling out loudly to bring in the conjurers, the Chaldeans and the astrologers. The king was answering and saying to the wise men of Babylon; Any man that will read this writing and show me its very interpretation, with purple he will be clothed, with a necklace of gold about his neck, and as the third one in the kingdom he will rule. (Daniel 5:7)
- And I myself have heard concerning you, that you are able to furnish interpretations and to untie knots themselves. Now, if you are able to read the writing and to make known to me its very interpretation, with purple you will be clothed, with a necklace of gold around your neck, and as the third one in the kingdom you will rule. (Daniel 5:16)
- At that time Daniel was answering and saying before the king;

Let your gifts prove to be to you yourself, and your presents do you give to others. However, I shall read the writing itself to the king, and the interpretation I shall make known to him. (Daniel 5:17)

- At that time Belshazzar commanded, and they clothed Daniel with purple, with a necklace of gold about his neck, and they heralded concerning him that he was to become the third ruler in the kingdom. (Daniel 5:29)
- The Midianites of Gideon's day put necklaces on the necks of their camels, and from these necklaces, apparently, moon-shaped ornaments hung as pendants.
- So Zebah and Zalmunna said; Get up yourself and assault us, for as a man is, so is his mightiness. Accordingly Gideon got up and killed Zebah and Zalmunna and took the moon-shaped ornaments that were on the necks of their camels. (Judges 8:21)
- And the weight of the nose rings of gold that he had requested amounted to one thousand seven hundred gold shekels, besides the moon-shaped ornaments and the eardrops and the garments of wool dyed reddish purple that were upon the kings of Midian and besides the necklaces that were on the necks of the camels. (Judges 8:26)
- Necklace-style chains were at times used for ornamentation, as for the temple pillars Jachin and Boaz.
- Then he made before the house two pillars, thirty-five cubits in length, and the capital that was upon the top of each one was five cubits. (2 Chronicles 3:15)
- Further, he made chains in necklace style and put them upon the tops of the pillars, and made a hundred pomegranates and put them on the chains. (2 Chronicles 3:16)
- And he proceeded to set up the pillars in front of the temple, one to the right and one to the left, after which he called the name of the right-hand one Jachin and the name of the left-hand one Boaz. (2 Chronicles 3:17)
- Of boastful, wicked people it is said that haughtiness has served as a necklace to them.

- For I became envious of the boasters, when I would see the very peace of wicked people. (Psalms 73:3)
- Therefore haughtiness has served as a necklace to them, violence envelops them as a garment. (Psalms 73:6)
- On the other hand, the discipline of a father and the Law of a mother are as a fine necklace to a sons throat.
- Listen, my son, to the discipline of your father, and do not forsake the Law of your mother. (Proverbs 1:8)
- For they are a wreath of attractiveness to your head and a fine necklace to your throat. (Proverbs 1:9)
