- The king provided what was needed for the daily sacrifices at the temple there in Jerusalem.
- And what is needed, young bulls as well as rams and lambs for the burnt offerings to the God of heaven, wheat, salt, wine and oil, just as the priests that are in Jerusalem say, let there be given them continually day by day without fail. (Ezra 6:9)
- Jesus showed that all that was needed to eat was a simple fare, but that Mary had chosen what was better, to be fed spiritually, and it would not be taken from her.
- A few things, though, are needed, or just one. For her part, Mary chose the good portion, and it will not be taken away from her. (Luke 10:42)
- Yehowah God is not attended to by human hands, as if he needed anything.
- Neither is he attended to by human hands as if he needed anything, because he himself gives to all persons life and breath and all things. (Acts of Apostles 17:25)
