~NEHILOTH (14)

(Ne'hi-loth)[Hebrew, nechi-lohth']

- A transliteration of *nechi-lohth'*, a Hebrew term of uncertain derivation and meaning, occurring only in the superscription of (Psalms Chapter 5) Nehiloth appears to be a musical expression, and many believe that it refers to a wind instrument, linking it with a Hebrew root related to *cha-lil'*, flute.
- However, the phrase, for Nehiloth may designate a melody. The Greek Septuagint and the Latin Vulgate render the term for her who inherits.
