

**~NEKODA 2 (27)**  
**(Ne-ko'da) [Speckled]**

- The forefather of a group unable to tell the house of their fathers and their origin.
- And these were the ones going up from Tel-melah, Tel-harsha, Cherub, Addon and Immer, and they proved unable to tell the house of their fathers and their origin, whether they were of Israel. (**Ezra 2:59**)
- The sons of Delaiah, the sons of Tobiah, the sons of **Nekoda**, six hundred and fifty-two. (**Ezra 2:60**)
- And these were the ones going up from Tel-melah, Tel-harsha, Cherub, Addon and Immer, and they were not able to tell the house of their fathers and their origin, whether they were of Israel. (**Nehemiah 7:61**)
- The sons of Delaiah, the sons of Tobiah, the sons of **Nekoda**, six hundred and forty-two. (**Nehemiah 7:62**)
- Since the names of Delaiah and Tobiah associated with **Nekoda** in these verses do not occur elsewhere in a list of returning exiles, it is assumed that this **Nekoda** is a person different from **NEKODA 1**.
