- The forefather of a group unable to tell the house of their fathers and their origin.
- And these were the ones going up from Tel-melah, Tel-harsha, Cherub, Addon and Immer, and they proved unable to tell the house of their fathers and their origin, whether they were of Israel. (Ezra 2:59)
- The sons of Delaiah, the sons of Tobiah, the sons of Nekoda, six hundred and fifty-two. (Ezra 2:60)
- And these were the ones going up from Tel-melah, Tel-harsha, Cherub, Addon and Immer, and they were not able to tell the house of their fathers and their origin, whether they were of Israel. (Nehemiah 7:61)
- The sons of Delaiah, the sons of Tobiah, the sons of Nekoda, six hundred and forty-two. (Nehemiah 7:62)
- Since the names of Delaiah and Tobiah associated with Nekoda in these verses do not occur elsewhere in a list of returning exiles, it is assumed that this Nekoda is a person different from NEKODA 1.
