~NEZIB (17) (Ne'zib) [from a root meaning, set up, station, erect]

- A Judean site in the Shephelah.
- This was the inheritance of the tribe of the sons of Judah by their families. (Joshua 15:20)
- In the Shephelah there were Eshtaol and Zorah and Ashnah. (Joshua 15:33)
- And Iphtah and Ashnah and Nezib. (Joshua 15:43)
- It is usually identified with Khirbet Beit Nesib, Horvat Neziv, about 11 kilometers (7 miles) Northwest of Hebron.
