~NOBAH 2 (25) (No'bah)

- A city East of the Jordan, captured by Nobah.
- And the sons of Machir the son of Manasseh proceeded to march to Gilead and to capture it and to drive away the Amorites who were in it. (Numbers 32:39)
- And Nobah marched and went capturing Kenath and its dependent towns, and he began to call it Nobah by his own name. (Numbers 32:42)
- Evidently the name **Nobah** did not stick, because later it is called by its original name, Kenath.
- Later Geshur and Syria took Havvoth-jair from them, with Kenath and its dependent towns, sixty cities. All these were the sons of Machir the father of Gilead. (1 Chronicles 2:23)
- The ruins at Kanaouat, about 90 kilometers (60 miles) Southeast of Damascus are commonly identified with the ancient site.
