~NOISE (216)

[English, sound, din, racket, clamor, clatter, blast, glare, Opposite of, silence]

- When Moses came down from the mountain of God, Joshua told him he had heard a noise like the noise of battle within the camp of Israel.
- And Joshua began to hear the **noise** of the people because of their shouting, and he proceeded to say to Moses; There is a noise of battle in the camp. (Exodus 32:17)
- When the Philistines drew up against Israel for battle, Yehowah God made it thunder with a loud noise so as to throw their camp into confusion.
- And it came about that while Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines themselves drew near for battle against Israel. And Yehowah now caused it to thunder with a loud noise on that day against the Philistines, that he might throw them into confusion, and they got defeated before Israel. (1 Samuel 7:10)
- When Solomon was anointed as king then the people made a loud noise with great rejoicing and the earth came to be split by the noise of them.
- After that all the people came on up following him, and the people were playing on flutes and rejoicing with great joy, so that the earth was split by the noise of them. (1 Kings 1:40)
- And Adonijah and all the ones invited that were with him got to hear it, when they themselves had finished eating. When Joab got to hear the sound of the horn, he at once said; What does the noise of the town in an uproar mean? (1 Kings 1:41)
- Then Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet anointed him as king in Gihon, after which they came up from there rejoicing, and the town is in an uproar. That was the noise that you men heard. (1 Kings 1:45)

- Yehowah God is stilling the noise of the seas, and the turmoil of the national groups.
- He is stilling the noise of the seas, the noise of their waves and the turmoil of the national groups. (Psalms 65:7)
- The Psalmist asked Yehowah God not to forget the voice or noise made by those rising up against him.
- Do not forget the voice of those showing hostility to you. The noise of those rising up against you is ascending constantly. (Psalms 74:23)
- Yehowah will lead all the nations against false religion and they will be boisterous or agitated to accomplish his one thought.
- The national groups will make a din, a noise, a background swell of propaganda and public sentiment, like the noise of a mighty waterfall, or the roaring of the sea in a storm.
- Ha for the commotion of many peoples, who are boisterous as with the boisterousness of the seas! And for the noise of national groups, who make a din just like the noise of mighty waters! (Isaiah 17:12)
- This mighty din of the nations, their noise or propaganda, will set in motion Yehowah's judgment against all religion. But, like the roaring of the seas, Yehowah will rebuke all of the nations, causing their din against all religion to subside and all of their din, talk against religion will flee, and be chased away like the chaff of the mountains, and like a thistle whirl before a stormwind, as he demonstrates his mighty power and Godship, before all of the worldly nations, bringing them to ruin.
- The national groups themselves will make a din just like the noise of many waters. And He will certainly rebuke it, and it must flee far away and be chased like the chaff of the mountains before a wind and like a thistle whirl before a storm wind. (Isaiah 17:13)
- The joyful harvest festivals with their boisterous music of tambourine, harp and dancing have ceased. The joyful noise of the highly elated ones has discontinued.

- The exultation of the tambourines has ceased, the noise of the highly elated ones has discontinued, the exultation of the harp has ceased. (Isaiah 24:8)
- Just as the shadow of clouds subdues the sweltering heat of the day in a waterless country, so likewise Yehowah will overshadow the tyrannical ones, suppressing their noisy melody, in their wicked hearts of tyranny, bringing relief to all the land.
- Like the heat in a waterless country, the noise of strangers you subdue, the heat with the shadow of a cloud. The melody itself of the tyrannical ones becomes suppressed. (Isaiah 25:5)
- Yehowah will cause his noise or voice to be heard to the farthest parts of the earth, through the writings of his word, the Son Of Man. Yehowah's controversy is with all the nations of the earth, who ruin and defile his beautiful earth, and who defiantly stand in the way of his universal sovereignty.
- A noise will certainly come clear to the farthest part of the earth, for there is a controversy that Yehowah has with the nations. He must personally put himself in judgment with all flesh. As regards the wicked ones, he must give them to the sword, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 25:31)
- They will then see, that the mighty Pharaoh, who represents Satan the Devil, is a mere noise, something, that passes quickly and it is no more. His long 6,000 year tenure as ruler of the earth is over, and his system must go in its entirety. The time for rejoicing by his people is over, their false religious festivals to their false idol gods must cease.
- There they have proclaimed, Pharaoh the king of Egypt is a mere noise. He has let the festal time pass by. (Jeremiah 46:17)
- The great voice of Babylon, is the voice of the Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses, a voice now being heard throughout the earth. She will be destroyed, because she does not speak truth, and does not want to be the one to reveal Yehowah's further purposes. She has rejected this privilege, choosing to honor herself, and her ideas, over those of God. The waves of truth will be boisterous, and they will come up over her like many waves of the sea, for the truth simply cannot be held back. The noise of her voice will fade out, for men will stop listening to her, she will become just noise.

- For Yehowah is despoiling Babylon, and he will certainly destroy out of her the great voice, and their waves will actually be boisterous like many waters. The noise of their voice will certainly be given out (Jeremiah 51:55)
- Yehowah God then tells Amos, that he will send the fire of war into Moab, and it must devour their dwelling towers in Kerioth, another of their principal cities. Thus with noise Moab would die, with an alarm signal, and the sounding of a horn of warning, one that would come too late to save her.
- And I will send a fire into Moab, and it must devour the dwelling towers of Kerioth, and with noise Moab must die, with an alarm signal, with the sound of a horn. (Amos 2:2)
- As they were gathered together there a noise occurred from heaven, for it was just like that of a rushing stiff breeze. This then filled the whole house where they were gathered together and praying.
- And suddenly there occurred from heaven a noise just like that of a rushing stiff breeze, and it filled the whole house in which they were sitting. (Acts of Apostles 2:2)
- Nonetheless, despite the telling in advance by thousands of years about this coming day of judgment with all mankind in writing through the Bible record, that day of accounting will still come as a thief upon the human family. They will not see it coming, but will only realize its presence after the fact, just as the visit of a thief is only realized after the fact, by observing the things that are now missing.
- Then the heavens that are now will pass away with a hissing noise as the gasses in the atmosphere are suddenly released, and the elements of the earth will melt, because of being intensely hot, and will be dissolved. Also the earth and all the hidden works in it will be discovered.
- These things have symbolic meaning primarily, for the heavens that are now are the wicked demonic rulers of the spiritual darkness we live in today, Satan the Devil and his demons. And the old earth which is governed over by wicked human rulers under Satan the Devil's control through the governments of men will come under the intense heat of Yehowah's inspection and will melt away to their eternal destruction.

- Likewise the works they worked to maintain, their rulership of the old earth, will be discovered, and their deceptions and their oppressions of mankind will be shown up and will end for all time.
- Also the elemental parts of Satan the Devil's system of things, the governments, false religion, commerce and the military will be dissolved away, and mankind will be set free of their wicked dominion. Praise Yehowah!
- Yet Yehowah's day will come as a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a hissing noise, but the elements being intensely hot will be dissolved, and earth and the works in it will be discovered. (2 Peter 3:10)
