## ~OBED-EDOM 2 (43) (O'bed-e'dom) [meaning, Servant of Edom]

- A musician and gatekeeper in the procession that brought the Ark to Jerusalem.
- And with them their brothers of the second division, Zechariah, Ben and Jaaziel and Shemiramoth and Jehiel and Unni, Eliab and Benaiah and Maaseiah and Mattithiah and Eliphelehu and Mikneiah, and Obed-edom and Jeiel the gatekeepers. (1 Chronicles 15:18)
- And Mattithiah and Eliphelehu and Mikneiah and Obed-edom and Jeiel and Azaziah with harps tuned to Sheminith, to act as directors. (1 Chronicles 15:21)
- He was likely the musician who continued to serve before the tent of the Ark in Jerusalem.
- Then he put before the ark of Yehowah some of the Levites as ministers, both to call to remembrance and to thank and praise Yehowah the God of Israel. (1 Chronicles 16:4)
- Asaph the head, and second to him Zechariah, and Jeiel and Shemiramoth and Jehiel and Mattithiah and Eliab and Benaiah and Obed-edom and Jeiel, with instruments of the string type and with harps, and Asaph with the cymbals playing aloud. (1 Chronicles 16:5)
- Then he left there before the ark of the covenant of Yehowah Asaph and his brothers to minister before the Ark constantly, according to the requirement of each day. (1 Chronicles 16:37)
- And Obed-edom and his brothers, sixty-eight, and Obed-edom the son of Jeduthun and Hosah as gatekeepers. (1 Chronicles 16:38)
