~OBED-EDOM 5 (22) (O'bed-e'dom) [meaning, Servant of Edom]

- Caretaker of the gold, silver, and other articles in the house of Yehowah during the reign of King Amaziah. When Jehoash of Israel invaded Jerusalem sometime between 858 B.C.E. and 844 B.C.E, these goods, and possibly Obed-edom himself, were all taken off to Samaria.
- And it was Amaziah the king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz, that Jehoash the king of Israel seized at Bethshemesh, after which he brought him to Jerusalem and made a breach in the wall of Jerusalem, from the Gate of Ephraim clear to the Corner Gate, four hundred cubits. (2 Chronicles 25:23)
- And he took all the gold and the silver and all the articles that were to be found in the house of the true God with Obed-edom and the treasures of the king's house and the hostages, and then returned to Samaria. (2 Chronicles 25:24)
