- The High Priest would fill his hand with power for seven days be standing and keeping the obligatory watch of Yehowah.
- And you will stay at the entrance of the tent of meeting day and night for seven days, and you must keep the obligatory watch of Yehowah, that you may not die, for so I have been commanded. (Leviticus 8:35)
- The obligatory service of the Gershomites was under the guidance of Ithamar.
- This is the service of the families of the sons of the Gershonites in the tent of meeting, and their obligatory service is under the hand of Ithamar the son of Aaron the priest. (Numbers 4:28)
