- The Psalmist complained about the shortness of his lifespan comparing it to a shadow that declines so that he is **obliged** to go away.
- Like a shadow when it declines, I am obliged to go away. I have been shaken off like a locust. (Psalms 109:23)
- Christ Jesus was obliged to become like his brothers in all respects so as to become a merciful and faithful High Priest.
- consequently he was obliged to become like his brothers in all respects, that he might become a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, in order to offer propitiatory sacrifice for the sins of the people. (Hebrews 2:17)
- The High Priest because of sinfulness is **obliged** to make sacrifice for his owns sins as much as for the peoples.
- And on its account he is **obliged** to make offerings for sins as much for himself as for the people. (Hebrews 5:3)
