[English, watching, viewing, scrutinizing, monitoring, studying, examining, surveying]

- Moses counseled Israel for there to be an observing during the month of Abib on the 14th day, the Passover.
- Let there be an observing of the month of Abib, and you must celebrate the Passover to Yehowah your God, because in the month of Abib Yehowah your God brought you out of Egypt by night. (Deuteronomy 16:1)
- Moses told the older men of Israel to be observing every commandment that Yehowah God was commanding his people.
- And Moses together with the older men of Israel went on to command the people, saying; There should be an observing of every commandment that I am commanding you today.

 (Deuteronomy 27:1)
- · All the paths of Yehowah God are loving-kindness and trueness, toward those who are observing his covenant and his reminders through his prophets.
- All the paths of Yehowah are loving-kindness and trueness for those observing his covenant and his reminders. (Psalms 25:10)
- The Psalmist showed that the wicked men were observing his steps to attack him, while they waited to take away his soul.
- They attack, they conceal themselves, they, for their part, keep observing my very steps, while they have waited for my soul. (Psalms 56:6)
- The Psalmist declared happy those who are observing justice, and doing righteousness all the time.
- Happy are those observing justice, doing righteousness all the time. (Psalms 106:3)
- The Psalmist declared happy those observing Yehowah God's reminders.

- Happy are those observing his reminders, with all the heart they keep searching for him. (Psalms 119:2)
- By observing the paths of judgment, Yehowah God will guard the very way of his loyal ones.
- By observing the paths of judgment, and he will guard the very way of his loyal ones. (Proverbs 2:8)
- The congregator showed that Yehowah God is always observing the hearts of mankind and he makes true assessments of their hearts.
- In case you should say; Look! We did not know of this, will not he himself that is making an estimate of hearts discern it, and he himself that is observing your soul know and certainly pay back to earthling man according to his activity? (Proverbs 24:12)
- An understanding son is one observing the Law, but a man having association with gluttons humiliates his father.
- An understanding son is observing the Law, but one having companionship with gluttons humiliates his father. (Proverbs 28:7)
- Jonah then showed, that those who are observing the idols of untruth, worshiped by the nations, leave their own loving-kindness. Yet true worshipers of Yehowah God know and understand the true loving-kindness of their God.
- As for those who are observing the idols of untruth, they leave their own loving-kindness. (Jonah 2:8)
- Jesus then watched as people were entering the temple, and were dropping in gifts of money into the treasury chests, and he was observing that many rich people were dropping in many coins.
- And he sat down with the treasury chests in view and began observing how the crowd was dropping money into the treasury chests, and many rich people were dropping in many coins. (Mark 12:41)
- So as they were observing him closely, to find a way to get at him, they decided to hire men secretly to go before him, and to pretend

that they were righteous, for he knew all of the chief priests and scribes. They did this, so that they might get an accusation against him, that they could present to the Roman authorities, so that they could hand him over to them, to have him killed.

- And, after observing him closely, they sent out men secretly hired to pretend that they were righteous, in order, that they might catch him in speech, so as to turn him over to the government and to the authority of the governor. (Luke 20:20)
- Then men, by observing, that the trees are budding in the springtime, certainly also know, that summer is approaching.
- When they are already in the bud, by observing it you know for yourselves that now the summer is near. (Luke 21:30)
- Then Jesus told these opposers, that they really did not know Yehowah God. Jesus however knew him, for he had lived in heaven alongside of him for eons of time, before ever coming to the earth as a man. So he told them, that if he were to say that he did not know Yehowah God, then he would be a liar if he did so. So he finished by telling them that he did know him, and was doing his will by observing his word.
- And yet you have not known him. But I know him. And if I said I do not know him I should be like you, a liar. But I do know him and am observing his word. (John 8:55)
- Then he gave a concrete example of why he had said that. For as he was entering their city, he was carefully observing their various objects of veneration, their idols, and there he had found an altar with an inscription, To An Unknown God. So Paul used this veneration to introduce them to a god, then unknown to them, Yehowah God, for this is the one he was publishing to them.
- For instance, while passing along and carefully observing your objects of veneration I also found an altar on which had been inscribed, To an Unknown God. Therefore what you are unknowingly giving godly devotion to, this I am publishing to you. (Acts of Apostles 17:23)
- So as it became day, they could see land nearby, but they could not recognize what land it was, and within their reach they were

observing a certain bay with a beach, and on this stretch, they were determined to land their ship if possible.

- Finally when it became day, they could not recognize the land but they were observing a certain bay with a beach, and on this they were determined, if they could, to beach the boat. (Acts of Apostles 27:39)
- They had turned back to scrupulously observing days and months and years, and festal seasons. Was this not done away with when the Law Covenant passed out of existence for them, when they were bought out from under it?
- You are scrupulously observing days and months and seasons and years. (Galatians 4:10)
- Anointed Christians know that they have come to know Christ because they are observing his commandments. Jesus Christ commanded his disciples to do the same things he did, and so anyone who copies his example laid out in the Bible record, knows him, for he is living the same course of life as Christ did.
- And by this we have the knowledge that we have come to know him, namely, if we continue observing his commandments. (1 John 2:3)
- Therefore anyone who says he has come to know Christ, and yet who is not observing his example, in his own life course, is a liar, and the truth is not in such a person.
- He that says; I have come to know him, and yet is not observing his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in this person. (1 John 2:4)
- Anointed Christians have the confidence in Yehowah God that he hears their every thought, and he knows their feelings even better than they do themselves. Therefore whatever they ask of God for assistance in the doing of his will, he hears it, and because they are doing his will, they know that they are to have the things needed to complete the doing of his will. John does not here mean that anything we might ask God for, he will hand over to us, for that is foolishness.
- And whatever we ask we receive from him, because we are observing his commandments and are doing the things that are

pleasing in his eyes. (1 John 3:22)

The scroll is now completely unsealed. Surely its complete fulfillment is ever so close. It is not enough just to say one has faith.

Faith is forward looking.
Ever Advancing
Watching for its cue.
It's trusting the things.
Yehowah promises.
Like we already knew.

- Happy then is the one observing the words by both seeing and acting upon all of the powerful wisdom, insights and understanding contained herein. Jesus said; I am coming quickly! Do not allow your outer garment to be taken, for Christ is coming as a thief!
- And, look! I am coming quickly. Happy is anyone observing the words of the prophecy of this scroll. (Revelation 22:7)
- Do not make the same mistake as the Governing Body of Jehovah's Witnesses who seek worshipful honors for providing food. Learn from the lesson! We are all good-for-nothing fellow slaves. We should do whatever we are told and observe the words of this scroll. Worship Yehowah God alone. He truly deserves our warm-hearted love and worship!
- But he tells me; Be careful! Do not do that! All I am is a fellow slave of you and of your brothers who are prophets and of those who are observing the words of this scroll. Worship God. (Revelation 22:9)
