(Och'ran) [from a root meaning, ostracism, trouble]

- An Asherite whose son Pagiel was appointed chieftain of the tribe of Asher after the Exodus from Egypt.
- Of Asher, Pagiel the son of Ochran. (Numbers 1:13)
- These are the ones called of the assembly, the chieftains of the tribes of their fathers. They are the heads of the thousands of Israel. (Numbers 1:16)
- And the ones camping alongside him will be the tribe of Asher, and the chieftain for the sons of Asher is Pagiel the son of Ochran. (Numbers 2:27)
- On the eleventh day there was the chieftain for the sons of Asher, Pagiel the son of Ochran. (Numbers 7:72)
- And for a communion sacrifice two cattle, five rams, five hegoats, five male lambs each a year old. This was the offering of Pagiel the son of Ochran. (Numbers 7:77)
- And over the army of the tribe of the sons of Asher there was Pagiel the son of Ochran. (Numbers 10:26)
