[English, unpleasant, nasty, distasteful, disgusting, odious, hateful, Opposite of, nice]

- The Israelites asked Yehowah to judge between Moses and Aaron and them for their words to Pharaoh had made them smell offensive before Pharaoh.
- At once they said to them; May Yehowah look upon you and judge, since you have made us smell offensive before Pharaoh and before his servants so as to put a sword in their hand to kill us. (Exodus 5:21)
- Manasseh turned all of Judah against Yehowah and did many offensive things to offend Yehowah.
- Nevertheless, Yehowah did not turn back from the great burning of his anger, with which his anger burned against Judah over all the offensive things with which Manasseh had made them offend. (2 Kings 23:26)
- No sooner had Yehowah brought his people into the Promised Land than they started worshipping idols and doing many offensive things toward him and his true worship.
- And I proceeded to bring them into the land that I had lifted up my hand in an oath to give them. When they got to see every exalted hill and every branchy tree, then they began sacrificing there their sacrifices and giving there their offensive offering, and presenting there their restful odors and pouring out there their drink offerings.
