(O-hol'i-bah) [My Tent of Worship Is in Her]

- In (Ezekiel Chapter 23), Jerusalem's unfaithfulness to Yehowah is portrayed under the allegory of the prostitute **Oholibah**. The meaning of the name **Oholibah** seems to allude to the fact that Yehowah's tent, or sanctuary, was in her territory.

- However, instead of appreciating this and taking to heart the punishment that came upon her sister Oholah or Samaria for unfaithfulness, **Oholibah** not only continued the record of infidelity begun in Egypt but conducted herself even worse than her sister.
- She practiced idolatry on a large scale and became politically involved with the Assyrians and the Babylonians. Consequently her former lovers, the Babylonians, were foretold to come against her and make her **a frightful object**.
