[English, ones Who, are in opposition to, go up against, are against, resist, combat, contest, fight, counter]

- Since the entire camp of Israel had gone unrestrained under Aaron, it became a disgrace to Yehowah and Moses and Joshua, who were the only ones opposed to it.
- And Moses got to see that the people went unrestrained, because Aaron had let them go unrestrained for a disgrace among their opposers. (Exodus 32:25)
- When Jesus healed a woman sick eighteen years with a flow of blood and his opposers objected, then he made them feel shame for their lack of compassion.
- Well, when he said these things, all his opposers began to feel shame, but all the crowd began to rejoice at all the glorious things done by him. (Luke 13:17)
- Yehowah promises to give to Christians a mouth and wisdom, courage to speak and the wisdom to know what to say, which all opposers will not be able to resist..
- For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your opposers together will not be able to resist or dispute. (Luke 21:15)
- Paul spoke of a large door that leads to activity, but there were many opposers to the expansion of Christianity.
- For a large door that leads to activity has been opened to me, but there are many opposers. (1 Corinthians 16:9)
