

### ~OPPOSING (33)

[English, opposite, contrasting, differing, disparate, conflicting, divergent, Opposite of, similar]

- When Paul spoke about the Kingdom of God to the proconsul Elymas began **opposing** him.
- But Elymas the sorcerer, that, in fact, is the way his name is translated, began **opposing** them, seeking to turn the proconsul away from the faith. ([Acts of Apostles 13:8](#))
- Paul tiring of **opposing** Jews said, let your blood come upon your own heads.
- But after they kept on **opposing** and speaking abusively, he shook out his garments and said to them; Let your blood be upon your own heads. I am clean. From now on I will go to people of the nations. ([Acts of Apostles 18:6](#))
- Christians are counseled to have wholesome speech so that any **opposers** would have nothing bad to say about them.
- Wholesome speech which cannot be condemned, so that the man on the **opposing** side may get ashamed, having nothing vile to say about us. ([Titus 2:8](#))
- James speaks against those who condemned the righteous ones among them, stating that God **opposes** them for doing this.
- You have condemned, you have murdered the righteous one. Is he not opposing you? ([James 5:6](#))
