

~**OPPOSITION (156)**

[English, resistance, antagonism hostility, disagreement, conflict, unfriendliness, Opposite of, **friendliness**]

- Nimrod displayed himself a mighty hunter in **opposition** to Yehowah God.
- He displayed himself a mighty hunter in **opposition** to Yehowah. That is why there is a saying; Just like Nimrod a mighty hunter in opposition to Yehowah. (**Genesis 10:9**)
- Moses warned Israel, that if they kept walking in **opposition** to him, he would inflict seven times more blows upon them as a discipline for their sins.
- But if you keep walking in **opposition** to me and not wishing to listen to me, I shall then have to inflict seven times more blows upon you according to your sins. (**Leviticus 26:21**)
- Moses told Israel, that if they walked in **opposition** to Yehowah God, that he would also walk in **opposition** to them.
- Nevertheless, if with these things you do not let yourselves be corrected by me and you just have to walk in **opposition** to me. (**Leviticus 26:23**)
- I, yes, I, shall then have to walk in **opposition** to you, and I, even I, shall have to strike you seven times for your sins. (**Leviticus 26:24**)
- If, however, with this you will not listen to me and you just must walk in **opposition** to me. (**Leviticus 26:27**)
- I shall then have to walk in heated **opposition** to you, and I, yes, I, shall have to chastise you seven times for your sins. (**Leviticus 26:28**)
- And they will certainly confess their own error and the error of their fathers in their unfaithfulness when they behaved unfaithfully toward me, yes, even when they walked in **opposition** to me. (**Leviticus 26:40**)

- Yet I, for my part, proceeded to walk in **opposition** to them, and I had to bring them into the land of their enemies. Perhaps at that time their uncircumcised heart will be humbled, and at that time they will pay off their error. (**Leviticus 26:41**)
- Job not realizing how Yehowah God really thought of him, figured that Yehowah God was walking in **opposition** to him.
- Look! Occasions for **opposition** to me he finds, the takes me for an enemy of his. (**Job 33:10**)
- There is no wisdom, discernment or fine counsel in **opposition** to Yehowah God.
- There is no wisdom, nor any discernment, nor any counsel in **opposition** to Yehowah. (**Proverbs 21:30**)
- Whether this twenty-one days was the same as the time period during which Daniel was fasting is not explicitly stated, but it is likely. During this time Gabriel was standing in **opposition** to the prince of Persia, likely one of Satan's followers. Then Michael came to support him and freed him up to come and answer Daniel's requests.
- But the prince of the royal realm of Persia was standing in **opposition** to me for twenty-one days, and, look! Michael, one of the foremost princes, came to help me, and I, for my part, remained there beside the kings of Persia. (**Daniel 10:13**)
- They complained that Jason has extended hospitality to these men, who themselves acted in **opposition** to the decrees of Caesar, by saying, there was another king, Jesus.
- And Jason has received them with hospitality. And all these men act in **opposition** to the decrees of Caesar, saying there is another king, Jesus. (**Acts of Apostles 17:7**)
- Now Paul showed, that before he became a Christian, that he really thought, that he should commit many acts of **opposition** against the name of Jesus the Nazarene.
- I, for one, really thought within myself I ought to commit many acts of **opposition** against the name of Jesus the Nazarene. (**Acts of Apostles 26:9**)

- Now from the standpoint of Jewish anointed Christians, Paul shows, that God blotted out the handwritten document against them, the Law Covenant, which consisted in decrees, and which was in **opposition** to their continued living of a self-guided way of life. He has thus taken this document out of the way, by nailing it to the torture stake of Christ.
- And blotted out the handwritten document against us, which consisted of decrees and which was in **opposition** to us, and He has taken it out of the way by nailing it to the torture stake. (**Colossians 2:14**)
- This Man of lawlessness, is set in **opposition** to the true way of Christianity, because of not being content with being a just a brother, among many brothers, he lifts himself up over all others who are God's holy anointed congregation, or ones who are considered holy ones. Then he sits down in God's temple, among his anointed sons, and publicly shows himself to be a god, by exercising religious authority over his brothers, like that, which the nations exercise.
- He is set in **opposition** and lifts himself up over everyone who is called **god** or an object of reverence, so that he sits down in the temple of The God, publicly showing himself to be a god. (**2 Thessalonians 2:4**)
- The Law is also for men who lie with males, kidnappers, liars and false swearers. It is against all of these ones, and also against whatever thing, is in **opposition** to the healthful teaching.
- Fornicators, men who lie with males, kidnappers, liars, false swearers, and whatever other thing is in **opposition** to the healthful teaching. (**1 Timothy 1:10**)
- To those who take up a habitual practice of sin, after their anointing, there remains nothing except a fearful expectation of judgment for them, for Yehowah God has a fiery jealousy, that will consume all those, who dare to stand in **opposition** to his undeserved kindness, expressed to them through his spirit.
- But there is a certain fearful expectation of judgment and there is a fiery jealousy that is going to consume those in **opposition**. (**Hebrews 10:27**)
