- Pharaoh set over Israel chiefs of forced labor for the purpose of **oppressing** Israel.
- So they set over them chiefs of forced labor for the purpose of **oppressing** them in their burden-bearing, and they went building cities as storage places for Pharaoh, namely, Pithom and Raamses. (**Exodus 1:11**)

- And to say to the sons of Israel; This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; It was I who brought Israel up out of Egypt and who went delivering you from the hand of Egypt and from the hand of all the kingdoms that were **oppressing** you. (**1 Samuel 10:18**)
- The Psalmist speaks prophetically about the Messiah over whom mortal man keep snapping all day long and keeps oppressing him.
- Show me favor, O God, because mortal man has snapped at me. Warring all day long, he keeps **oppressing** me. (**Psalms 56:1**)
