- The people of Laish were dwelling in security with no one oppressing them.
- Accordingly the five men went on and came to Laish and saw how the people that were within it were dwelling in self-reliance according to the custom of the Sidonians, quiet and unsuspecting, and there was no oppressive conqueror that was molesting a thing in the land, while they were far off from the Sidonians and they had nothing to do with mankind. (Judges 18:7)
- Jerusalem is mentioned as the oppressive city that went on rebelling and polluting herself.
- Woe to her that is rebelling and polluting herself, the oppressive city! (Zephaniah 3:1)
- Paul warned about oppressive wolves who would enter in among you, the body of elders, who would not properly shepherd the flock, but would rule over it for their own gain.
- I know that after my going away oppressive wolves will enter in among you and will not treat the flock with tenderness. (Acts of Apostles 20:29)
