~OPPRESSORS (75)

[English, tormentors, tyrants, bullies, teasers]

- Melchizedek blessed Abraham because Yehowah God had delivered Abraham's oppressors into his hand.
- And blessed be the Most High God, who has delivered your oppressors into your hand! At that Abram gave him a tenth of everything. (Genesis 14:20)
- Moses prophesied about Israel that he would consume his oppressors and gnaw on their bones.
- God is bringing him out of Egypt. The swift course of a wild bull is his. He will consume the nations, his oppressors, and their bones he will gnaw, and he will break them to pieces with his arrows. (Numbers 24:8)
- Many times Yehowah God acted as a judge of Israel and delivered them from the hands of their oppressors.
- And when Yehowah did raise up judges for them, Yehowah proved to be with the judge, and he saved them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge, for Yehowah would feel regret over their groaning because of their oppressors and those who were shoving them around. (Judges 2:18)
- So I delivered you out of the hand of Egypt and out of the hand of all your oppressors and drove them out from before you and gave you their land. (Judges 6:9)
- The congregator saw that those being oppressed had no comforter for their oppressors were in power over them.
- And I myself returned that I might see all the acts of oppression that are being done under the sun, and, look! The tears of those being oppressed, but they had no comforter, and on the side of their oppressors there was power, so that they had no comforter. (Ecclesiastes 4:1)
- This pillar will be a sign symbolizing peace with God, and so when they are oppressed and they cry out to God, he will come to their

help to rescue them. He will send a grand savior into Egypt, who will free all of Egypt from the oppressive and demonic system, that has so long controlled all of the earth, and he will actually deliver them.

- And it must prove to be for a sign and for a witness to Yehowah of armies in the land of Egypt, for they will cry out to Yehowah because of the oppressors, and he will send them a savior, even a grand one, who will actually deliver them. (Isaiah 19:20)
- Then Yehowah will multiply his people like the sands of the seas as in the times of long ago. The way of the truth will then become firmly established. Also, all of the oppressive nations, that abused his people down through time, he will give his attention to them, and bring them to ruin. True worship will be given a place on earth, a place of honor and respect for the thousand years.
- And his sons must become as in former times, and before me his own assembly will be firmly established. And I will turn my attention upon all his oppressors. (Jeremiah 30:20)
