

~ORDERING (37)

- The Levites were **ordering** the people to keep silent from their mourning for this was a day of rejoicing, a holy day
- And the Levites were **ordering** all the people to be silent, saying; Keep quiet! For this day is holy, and do not feel hurt. (**Nehemiah 8:11**)
- After Jesus had been **ordering** the unclean spirit to leave the demon possessed man it spoke.
- For he had been **ordering** the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For over a long time it had held him fast, and he was repeatedly bound with chains and fetters under guard, but he would burst the bonds and be driven by the demon into the lonely places. (**Luke 8:29**)
- Paul and Silas were beaten and then they threw them into prison, **ordering** the jailer to keep them securely.
- After they had inflicted many blows upon them, they threw them into prison, **ordering** the jailer to keep them securely. (**Acts of Apostles 16:23**)
- The military commander looking after Paul's welfare **ordered** the young man not to blab to others that he had warned him, for this would endanger his men and ultimately Paul himself.
- Therefore the military commander let the young man go after **ordering** him; Do not blab to anyone that you have made these things clear to me. (**Acts of Apostles 23:22**)
