~ORIGINATES (81)

[English, creates, invents, initiates, instigates, starts off, makes]

- Then he told her that as a Samaritan, she worshiped what she did not know, for their way of worship originated with men, first under wicked king Jeroboam, with a man appointed way of worship, and priesthood, and with idol worship. The Jews on the other hand had remained true to the way of worship that God instituted from the time of Moses and forward, with its true God appointed priesthood and temple.
- You worship what you do not know, we worship what we know, because salvation originates with the Jews. (John 4:22)
- John now elucidates specifically on what he means. He shows that everything in the world, the desires of the flesh, and the desires of ones eyes, and to put on a showy display of ones means of maintenance for others to see, none of these things originate with the Father, but come from the world, and are part of its thinking and ways.
- Because everything in the world, the desire of the flesh and the desire of the eyes and the showy display of ones means of life, does not originate with the Father, but originates with the world. (1 John 2:16)
- John was writing his letter to ones known and beloved to him, whom he knew were genuine anointed Christians, and who had this spirit anointing from Yehowah God. They knew the truth, and thus they could discern, that no lie originates with the truth. They are directly opposed to one another.
- I write you, not because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and because no lie originates with the truth. (1 John 2:21)
- Anyone who carries on sin, is a child of Satan the Devil, because the Devil has been sinning from the beginning of the human experience. So for this very purpose the Son of God came forth, to break up the works and thinking of the Devil, and to bring them to nothing.
- He who carries on sin originates with the Devil, because the Devil

has been sinning from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was made manifest, namely, to break up the works of the Devil. (1 John 3:8)

- How though, can one test out these inspired expressions to know, that they originate with Yehowah God. One way that John mentions, is that every inspired expression that is from Yehowah God, must confess that Jesus Christ came in the flesh as a man on earth.
- Think today of how many professed Christians do not believe this, and you will see how they have been deceived by false inspired expressions, which later become wrong doctrine, if they are wrongly accepted as truth.
- You gain the knowledge of the inspired expression from God by this. Every inspired expression that confesses Jesus Christ as having come in the flesh originates with God. (1 John 4:2)
- John now encourages Gaius to become an imitator of what is good, and not of what is bad. The one doing good originates with God, for God is good. He that does bad, does not really know God, though he may claim to.
- Beloved one, be an imitator, not of what is bad, but of what is good. He that does good originates with God. He that does bad has not seen God. (3 John 1:11)
